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William E. Wilson Lantern Slides

106 glass plate, lantern slides produced by William E. Wilson, photographer. These have been digitized and catalogued. Many are identical to images in the Wilson Collection.

William E. Wilson Personal Collection

Lantern slides used in the photographer's business and collected for personal use. Stereograph images from his personal collection.

The Bell, Brooks, Sandoz and Gaines Collections

The Bell and Olive Brooks collections consist of thirty-six photographs taken of Mobile structures in the early part of the 20th century.

The Sandoz collection consists of 13 albumen prints produced during the spring and summer of 1891. These are views in and around Mobile, including 2 aerials and several images buildings at Fort Morgan.

The Gaines collection is comprised digital images of one hundred nine photographs. The category headings are flowers, people and rural scenes. These photographs were taken in Alabama and Mississippi. Around 2007 the prints in the collection were transferred to the Columbus Lowndes County Public Library.

The HMPS Collection

A collection of more than 1000 photographs donated to the Society over time from multiple sources. When possible the sources of a photograph and the photographer have been attributed. The collection covers a wide range of subjects with the dates ranging from the mid 19th century to the present.

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1892 Mobile

A collection of 38 photogravure images in a souvenir book published by the E. O. Zadek Jewelry Company's stationary department in Mobile, 1892.

Historic American Buildings Survey 1936

291 black and white photographs of houses and architectural details interior and exterior, in Mobile, representing a portion of the survey collection maintained at the Library of Congress.

Mayton Collection

A large uncatalogued collection of photographs taken in and around Mobile by William T. Mayton during the later 20th century. The collection consists of negatives, prints, slides and medium format images covering a variety of subjects.

HMPS Library

Approximately 1100 volumes including US History, Alabama History, Religion, Mobile History, Mobile Literature and Reference.

George B. Rogers Library

Over 400 volumes published between 1890 and 1940 covering interior design, landscape gardening, architectural detail and a variety of architectural styles ranging from Ancient Rome to more modern steel and reinforced concrete.
